

## **KCA Summer Standard Open 2026 Regulation**

### **1. Invitation**

Kidult Chess Academy (KCA) is honoured to invite chess players from all FIDE member federations with a **Standard FIDE rating below 1800** to participate in the KCA Summer Standard Open 2026.

### **2. Playing Venue**

The playing venue is located at 18/F, The Hedon, 11 Matheson Street, Causeway Bay, Hong Kong.

### **3. Participation and Conditions**

The entry fee is

HKD \$800 for Standard;

HKD \$450 for Blitz;

HKD \$450 for Rapid.

With a discounted package of \$1500 for Standard, Rapid and Blitz.

This event supports and acts as a warm up for Asian Rapid and Blitz Championship 2026 by using the same time control. In addition, for players that have registered "Asian Rapid and Blitz Championship 2026", they can enjoy a further HKD \$200 discount.

### **4. Tournament Format**

4.1) The tournament will be played using the Swiss System over 7 rounds.

4.2) Rate of play: 30 minutes for the whole game plus a 30-second increment starting from move 1.

4.3) The latest FIDE Laws of Chess shall apply.

4.4) The zero-tolerance rule shall not apply. The default time (late arrival) is set at 30 minutes.

4.5) Two defaults or "no-shows" will result in automatic withdrawal from the tournament.

4.6) Players who do not show up will not be paired for subsequent rounds unless a written declaration is signed.

4.7) Bye Requests:

- A half-point (0.5) bye may be requested for Rounds 1 to 3.
- All bye requests must be submitted in writing to the Chief Arbiter before the end of the previous round.

## 5. Playing Hall

5.1) Strictly no food (including candy or snacks) and no drinks (except water) are allowed in the tournament venue.

5.2) All players and spectators must strictly adhere to the rules and instructions provided by the arbiters.

5.3) Electronic equipment of any kind (mobile phones, smartwatches, etc.) is strictly prohibited in the playing hall. KCA reserves the right to use metal detectors for checking.

## 7. Prizes

### Standard tournament

Champion: \$1500 HKD + Medal

1st Runner up: \$1000 HKD + Medal

2nd Runner up: \$800 HKD + Medal

U14 Top 3 and Best Girl: Medal

U10 Top 3 and Best Girl: Medal

### Rapid tournament

Champion: \$1000 HKD + Medal

1st Runner up: \$800 HKD + Medal  
2nd Runner up: \$500 HKD + Medal  
U14 Top 3 and Best Girl: Medal  
U10 Top 3 and Best Girl: Medal

#### Blitz tournament

Champion: \$1000 HKD + Medal  
1st Runner up: \$800 HKD + Medal  
2nd Runner up: \$500 HKD + Medal  
U14 Top 3 and Best Girl: Medal  
U10 Top 3 and Best Girl: Medal

Each player is eligible to win one prize only in each tournament (the higher-valued prize will be awarded).

#### **8. Tie-break Rules**

In the event of a tie in points, the following tie-breaks will apply in order:

- a) Direct Encounter (only if all tied players have played each other)
- b) Buchholz
- c) Buchholz Cut 1
- d) Buchholz Cut 2
- e) Buchholz Cut 3

If the above is insufficient, they will be joint champions and share the prize equally.

#### **9. Appeals Procedure**

9.1) Protests against decisions made by the Chief Arbiter or the arbiter team must be submitted in writing and signed by the player. Protests must be handed to the Chairman of the Appeals Committee within 30 minutes of the completion of the disputed game/event.

9.2) A protest fee of HKD \$1,500 must be submitted with the written protest. The fee will be refunded if the protest is upheld; otherwise, it will be forfeited.

9.3) Appeals Committee (AC) will be declared in the players' meeting before the tournament starts. The AC consists of a Chairman, at least two members and, when needed, two reserve members. The Chairman, the members and reserve members shall, if possible, be from different federations. No member of the AC involved in the dispute shall rule in that dispute. Such a committee should have an odd number of voting members. Members of the AC shall not be younger than 21 years old.
